## Laurie R. Blank

CLINICAL PROFESSOR OF LAW, EMORY UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF LAW

Laurie R. Blank is a clinical professor of law and the director of the International Humanitarian Law Clinic at Emory University School of Law. Before coming to Emory, Blank was a program officer in the Rule of Law program at the United States Institute of Peace, where she directed the Experts' Working Group on International Humanitarian Law. She is the series editor of the International Committee of the Red Cross's teaching supplements on international humanitarian law, a member of the American Bar Association's Advisory Committee to the Standing Committee on Law and National Security, and a member of the Public

Interest Law and Policy Group's High Level Working Group on Piracy. Blank has written articles on international humanitarian law and is the co-author of *International Law and Armed Conflict: Fundamental Principles and Contemporary Challenges in the Law of War* (2013) and *Law of War Training: Resources for Military and Civilian Leaders* (2013). She received an AB in politics from Princeton University, an MA in international relations from the Paul H. Nitze School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS) at Johns Hopkins University, and a JD from New York University School of Law.
