Rebecca Oldroyd joined Deseret Mutual Benefit Administrators (DMBA) as senior counsel in 2013, a nonprofit organization that administers employee benefits for organizations owned by or affiliated with The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Oldroyd had been a business development manager at CAMRIS International, a Maryland-based international development company since 2010. Previously, she had been in private practice with Groom Law Group in Washington, D.C., as an employee benefits associate focused on retirement plans. Following her graduation from law school in 2005, Oldroyd joined the Chicago offices of Kirkland & Ellis as an associate with the employee benefits practice group and specialized in employee benefit plan issues in mergers and acquisitions. She had interned with Utah Governor Michael Leavitt and with Justice Michael Wilkins at the Utah Supreme Court, and before attending law school, she worked with the State of Utah Olympic Office. Oldroyd loves international travel and has visited forty countries. She graduated with honors with a BS in social work and a JD from Brigham Young University. While attending BYU, she interned in the Washington, D.C., office of Senator Orrin Hatch and spent a semester at the BYU Jerusalem Center.
