Adam Liptak covers the Supreme Court for the *New York Times*. Liptak's column on legal affairs, "Sidebar," appears every other Tuesday. He was awarded the Scripps Howard Award for Washington reporting in 2011 for an examination of the first five years of the Robert's court and a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize in explanatory reporting in 2009 for "American Exception," a series of articles

examining ways in which the American legal system differs from those of other developed nations. Liptak has taught media law at the Columbia University School of Journalism, UCLA Law School, and Yale Law School. A graduate of Yale College and Yale Law School, he practiced law in New York City and in the legal department of the *New York Times* before joining the news staff in 2002.
