Julius Anderegg was appointed Swiss consul general to San Francisco in 2009, with responsibilities in ten western states. Since joining the Swiss Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1977, Anderegg's diplomatic assignments have included Frankfurt am Main and Karachi (consul general), New York (diplomatic counsellor, Swiss Mission to the UN), Vienna (chairman, OSCE's Committee for Financial and Economic Affairs), Geneva (deputy director, EFTA), Berne (political

directorate), Bagdad and Copenhagen (deputy head of embassy), and Barcelona and New York (commercial attaché). He spent his youth in the beautiful Swiss ski resort of Klosters, studied business administration in Switzerland as well as comparative politics and international relations at CUNY and Columbia University and received an MA in political sciences from the CUNY Graduate Center. Anderegg and his wife Ursula are the parents of a son and a daughter.
