Christian Haskett is a visiting faculty of religious studies at Utah State University and will join the faculty of Centre College in Kentucky this fall. Haskett is a scholar of Indian and Tibetan religions in both the ancient and modern worlds and has spent three and a half years researching in Buddhist monasteries in India. His research

interests focus on Indian Buddhism ritual and Tibetan and Sanskrit philology. He previously taught at Washington and Lee University. Haskett received an MA in religion from Columbia University (1999) and a PhD in languages and cultures of Asia from the University of Wisconsin—Madison (2010).
