PORTUGUESE AMBASSADOR TO THE U.S.

His Excellency Nuno Brito was appointed Portuguese ambassador to the U.S. in 2011. Brito was previously the political director of Portugal and co-chair of the Portuguese–U.S. Standing Bilateral Commission. His distinguished career has included service as the senior diplomatic advisor of the prime minister (2002–05), director-general for European affairs, co-chair of the Luso-Spanish Transborder Cooperation Commission, and counselor to the Economic and Social Council. He became a deputy permanent representative to

the United Nations in 1999, was posted as deputy alternate representative to the Security Council of the Portuguese Mission to the United Nations in 1997, and was appointed to the cabinet of the Portuguese Foreign Minister in 1995. Brito also served at the Portuguese Embassy in Washington (1987–93) after he joined the Portuguese diplomatic service in 1984. He received a law degree from the University of Lisbon. Brito and his wife are the parents of two children.
