SWISS AMBASSADOR TO THE UN

His Excellency Paul R. Seger was appointed Swiss ambassador to the UN in 2010. Prior to his appointment, Seger had served as legal advisor and head of the Directorate of International Law of Switzerland's Federal Department of Foreign Affairs since 2003; as deputy chief of mission of the Swiss Embassy in Buenos Aires (2000–03); as head of the International Law Section and deputy head of the Division for International Law, Human Rights, and Humanitarian Law of

the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (1995–2000). His earlier assignments included legal advisor for Switzerland's Permanent Observer Mission to the UN in New York and deputy chief of mission of the Swiss Embassy in Kinshasa. Seger received a law degree from the University of Basel and is a faculty lecturer there. He speaks German, English, French, and Spanish. He and his wife are the parents of two sons.
