Gareth Harding

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF JOURNALISM AND BRUSSELS PROGRAM DIRECTOR,
UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI—COLUMBIA

Gareth Harding is an assistant professor of journalism at the University of Missouri—Columbia and director of the Missouri School of Journalism's Brussels Program, which was launched in January 2008. Harding is a Brussels-based freelance journalist with more than a decade of experience writing about the European Union and European politics. Before that, he worked as a speech writer and political advisor in the British and European Parliaments. He has written for *Time* magazine, United Press International, the *Washington Times*, the *Wall Street Journal*,

and many other outlets. Harding has been a tutor at the European Journalism Centre for nine years and is also a documentary filmmaker and media trainer. He was educated at the London School of Economics where he studied history and politics and worked as a political advisor in the House of Commons, the European Commission, and European Parliament before becoming a journalist. A native of Wales, Harding considers Brussels his adopted home, and he speaks French and Spanish and basic Norwegian and German.
