His main research interests include economic history, Latin American history, natural resource policy, and tourism development. Ward has traveled, worked, and

researched in many places around the world, including Argentina, Austria, Chile, China, Colombia, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Germany, India, Japan, México, Nepal, Peru, Turkey, and Uruguay, with a strong interest in culture and languages.
