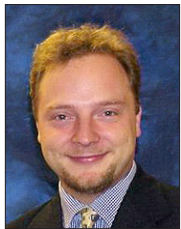

Pavel Černoč is an editor at the European Parliament with expertise in governance, management and education. Černoč previously served as a counselor with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the Czech Republic and as a policy research fellow with the Open Society Institute, where his research focused on EU relations with southeast Europe and the Black Sea Region. He has been a visiting professor at Grinnell College in Iowa,

teaching European politics, and he taught European integration courses at the prestigious Jean Monnet Centre of Charles University in Prague, where he completed his PhD dissertation on the impact of EU enlargement. As a Czech citizen, Černoč grew up in Germany between Nuremberg-Marienbad-Prague and was an active participant in the 1989 events that led to democracy for the Czech Republic. He received an MA 1995.
