CAMBODIAN AMBASSADOR TO THE U.S.

His Excellency Hem Heng was appointed Cambodian ambassador to the U.S. in 2009, having previously served as director of the Asia 2 Department at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (2006–08; 2001–04), advisor to Deputy Prime Minister Hor Namhong (2004–08), and director of information and documentation at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (2004/06). Heng's extensive diplomatic service has included embassies in India and Vietnam and positions in the Ministry of Foreign

Affairs. He received a high diploma from the Agricultural School of Prek Leap in Cambodia; a public administration certificate from the Royal School of Administration in Cambodia; a diploma in international law, international organizations, and diplomacy from the Indian Academy of International Law and Diplomacy in New Delhi; and a master's degree in political science from the University of Delhi in India. Heng speaks English and French, and he and his wife are the parents of three sons.
