CHILEAN AMBASSADOR TO THE U.S.

Arturo Fermandois was appointed Chilean ambassador to the U.S. in 2010. Fermandois is a founding partner of Fermandois, Evans y Cia law firm and previously worked at the Studies and Foreign Trade Section of the prosecutor's office of Banco del Estado de Chile. Throughout his legal career, he served as an advisor to the negotiating team for the North America Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), arbiter of the Arbitration and Mediation Center of the Santiago Chamber of Commerce, and a member of the ICARE Legal Association as well as of the Chilean Association of Constitutional Law. As

an academic, Fermandois was a teacher at Harvard University and an associate professor at the Law School of Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, where he held the chairs of constitutional law and applied law. He is also the author of various legal books and publications, such as "Economic Constitutional Law" and "Applied Constitutional Law," among others. He graduated from Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile and received an MPA from Harvard University, where he continues to be a member of the Dean's Leadership Advisory Council of the John F. Kennedy School of Government.
