Hans Arnold has helped define U.S.–German relations for nearly half a century. Currently a lecturer at the Academy for Political Science (*Hochschule für Politik*) in Munich, Arnold served in the German Foreign Service from 1951 to 1986. His foreign posts have taken him from Paris to Washington, D.C., with service as an ambassador in Den Haag and Rome. He has been an active and prominent participant in German and European debates. In addition to frequent newspaper articles and television appearances, Arnold has written several books about German security and European unification, which include *How much Unification does Europe Need?* (2004), *Europe To Be Thought Anew: Why and How Further Unification?* (1999), and *Security for Europe* (co-ed, 2002).
