Ronen Sen was appointed ambassador on 15 September 2004. Sen has had a distinguished career in the Foreign Service since 1966, having served as high commissioner to the United Kingdom (2002–04), and ambassador to Germany (1998–2002), Russia (1992–98), and Mexico (1991–92); as joint secretary to the Indian prime minister (1986–91), joint secretary in the Ministry of External Affairs (1984–85), and secretary to the Atomic Energy Commission of India. From 1968 to 1984, he held posts in Moscow, San Francisco, and Dhaka. He has participated in summit meetings with the United Nations, Commonwealth, Non-Aligned Movement, Six Nation Five Continent Peace Initiative, South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation, International Atomic Energy Agency, G-15 and other forums, as well as more than 160 bilateral summit meetings. Sen and his wife, Kalpana, have one daughter.
