Alessandro Trojani is a specialist in oral history and digital data processing technologies in the humanities. At the present time, Trojani is a professor of multimedia computer science and e-learning at the University of Florence, in both the Information Science Department and the Political Science Department. He also teaches U.S. history. Since 2003, he has been the director of the project “Italians in the Gold Rush and Beyond” (<http://www.igrb.net>), a project co-financed by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Rome), the Consulate of Italy (Los Angeles and San Francisco), the University of Florence, and U.S. universities, including collaboration with California State University at San Bernardino for GIS projects. Trojani is the author of *Go West! Looking for Italians in the American West* (2003) and *Informatica e Multimedia* (2006), and he is currently writing several other publications.
