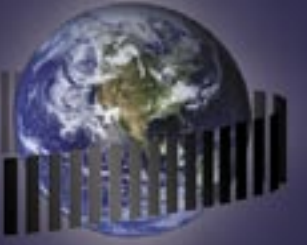

# Ukrainian Revolution: Past, Present, and Future

Anatoly Nikitin has served as the department head at the Institute of Mathematics in the Ukraine since 1997. Nikitin began as a research fellow in 1974, and then became the senior and leading researcher at the Institute of Mathematics, National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine. As a top researcher in his field, Nikitin explored the theory of relativistic particles, supersymmetry, quantum field theory, and group theory. He has been presented with many honors and awards for his research, in addition to publishing numerous works in the field. He received the 2002 State Award of the Ukraine for monographs in mathematical physics. Nikitin completed a master of science in physics in 1969 from Kyiv National Taras Shevchenko University, and then received a PhD in mathematics and theoretical physics from the Institute of Mathematics, Kyiv in 1974. Nikitin's native languages are Ukrainian and Russian, and he is fluent in both English and Czech. He and his wife have two daughters.
