Kenneth A. Osgood joined Florida Atlantic University (FAU) in 2001. Osgood's current research involves war and public diplomacy. He was the Mary Ball Washington Chair in American History at University College Dublin in Ireland during the 2006–07 academic year. His publications include *Total Cold War: Eisenhower's Secret Propaganda Battle at Home and Abroad* (2006), the *Cold War after Stalin's Death: A Missed Opportunity for Peace?* (edited with Klaus Larres, 2006). At FAU in 2006, he received the Researcher of the Year Award for the College of Arts and Letters, and in 2004, he received the University Award for Excellence in Teaching. Osgood received a BA in history magna cum laude from the University of Notre Dame (1994) and an MA and a PhD in history from the University of California—Santa Barbara (1997, 2001).
