Her Excellency Hunaina bint Sultan Al-Mughairy was appointed ambassador on 2 December 2005. Prior to that, Al-Mughairy had served as the commercial attaché at the Permanent Mission of Oman to the United Nations in New York (1999–2005), director general of Investment Promotion for the Omani Center for Investment Promotion and Export Development (1996–98), and advisor to the Undersecretary for Industry (1991–96) and director of Industrial Planning and Research (1985–91) at the Ministry of Commerce and Industry. She also served at the Permanent Mission of the Sultanate of Oman to the United Nations in Geneva (1984–85). And from 1979 to 1984 she held positions as the director of Industrial Loans and Grants at the Ministry of Commerce and Industry and as a member of the planning committee for major gas projects in the Sultanate of Oman. Al-Mughairy received a B.Com from the High Polytechnical Institute in Cairo, Egypt, and an MA from New York University. Her husband, Fuad bin Mubarak Al-Hinai, Permanent Representative to the UN in New York, will accompany her.
