Elizabeth Pond, a journalist based in Berlin, Germany, is a correspondent for the *Washington Quarterly* and editor of *Transatlantic Internationale Politik*. Pond is also a non-resident Fellow at the Center for Transatlantic Relations. Her specialty is tracking the dynamics of transformations. She served as a foreign correspondent for the *Christian Science Monitor* in Asia and Europe before she turned to writing books with grants from a variety of think tanks—most recently, the U.S. Institute of Peace. Her numerous publications include *Endgame in the Balkans: Regime Change, European Style* (2006) and *Friendly Fire: The Near-Death of the Transatlantic Alliance* (2004). She is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations, the German Council on Foreign Relations (where she edited the English-language foreign-policy quarterly for six years), the International Institute for Strategic Studies, and Women in International Security.
