Robert D. Schulzinger has been at the University of Colorado—Boulder since 1977. Schulzinger has authored or co-authored twelve books, among which are *A Time For War: The United States and Vietnam, 1941–1975* (1997) and *A Time for Peace: The Legacy of the Vietnam War* (2006). A former president of the Society for Historians of American Foreign Relations, he is editor-in-chief of the society's journal, *Diplomatic History*. From 1996 to 2005, he was member of the Historical Advisory Committee of the U.S. State Department, which he chaired from 2001 to 2003. He is currently a member of the Historical Review Panel of the Central Intelligence Agency. Schulzinger received a PhD from Yale University (1971).
