Lynn Elliott returned to BYU as assistant director of the Kennedy Center and ISP director in 2004. Elliott had been the International Center's associate director and study abroad director at Utah Valley State College since 2001, and prior to that, he had coordinated tours with BYU's Performing Arts Management in over forty countries, including groundbreaking tours to Vietnam, Indonesia, Armenia, and West Africa. His first trip overseas was with the BYU International Folk Dance Ensemble on their tour to Japan, Korea, and the Philippines. He received a BA in economics from BYU, and by the time Elliott left BYU with an MA in international relations, he had toured twenty countries and decided to pursue a career in international education. As a PhD candidate, he specialized in East European politics and served as assistant director for that college's study abroad program in Poland.
