EGYPTIAN AMBASSADOR TO THE U.S.

His Excellency Sameh Shoukry was appointed ambassador in 2008, having previously served as Egypt's permanent representative to the UN in Geneva (2005–08) as well as ambassador to Austria and permanent representative to the International Organizations in Vienna (1999–2003). Shoukry also served as director of cabinet for the minister of foreign affairs (2004–05) and as secretary for information and follow-up for President Hosni Mubarak (1995–99).

As a career diplomat who joined the diplomatic corps in 1976, he served in the Egyptian embassies in London and Buenos Aires as well as the Egyptian Permanent Mission in New York. In addition, he headed the Department of the United States and Canada in the Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs (1994–95). Shoukry received a law degree from Ein Shams University. He and his wife are the parents of two sons.
