Brian C. Etheridge holds the John D. Winters Endowed Professorship in History at Louisiana Tech University, where he directs the university honors program and American Foreign Policy Center. In 2009, Etheridge received the Stuart L. Bernath Scholarly Article Prize, awarded by the Society for Historians of American Foreign Relations for the best article in the field of American foreign relations by a younger

scholar. He is co-editor of *The United States and Public Diplomacy: New Directions in Cultural and International History* and is revising his manuscript, *Nazis and Berliners: Germany's Place in America's Cold War Story*, for publication. Etheridge serves as web master and editor for SHAFR.org, the web site of the Society for Historians of American Foreign Relations.
