Perezi Kamunanwire was appointed ambassador of Uganda to the U.S. in 2006, having served previously as his country's permanent representative to the UN in New York (1988–96) and as ambassador to Germany (1986–88). Kamunanwire co-edited *A Study Guide to Uganda* and contributed the foreword to *We, the PanAfrikans: Essays on the Global Black Experience*, in addition to writing many other scholarly articles in the field of international relations. In recent years, he has been an educator and scholar. Beginning in 2003, he served as an adjunct professor at the Center for Conflict Management and Organizational Research associated with Sophia University in Bulgaria. And previously he taught at the City College of the City University of New York, where he also directed programs in black studies and international relations. Kamunanwire, who was educated at Columbia University in New York, is fluent in English and five African languages, including Lingala, Swahili, and Kinyrwanda.
