Gabriel Weimann, a professor of communications at Haifa University in Israel, is currently on a one-year teaching assignment at the American University School of International Service in Washington, D.C. Weimann's research interests include the study of media effects, political campaigns, persuasion and influence, media and public opinion, and modern terrorism and the mass media. His most recent books are *Terror on the Internet* (2007), the *Singaporean Enigma* (2001), and *Communicating Unreality* (2000), as well as

having published numerous papers and research reports in scientific journals and books. He has received numerous grants and awards from international foundations and has been a visiting professor at various universities including University of Pennsylvania, Stanford University, Hofstra University, Lehigh University (USA), University of Mainz (Germany), Carleton University (Canada), and the National University of Singapore.
