PROFESSOR OF CONTEMPORARY HISTORY, UNIVERSITY OF PARIS,
PANTHÉON-SORBONNE

Dominique Kalifa is a professor of contemporary history at the University of Paris, Panthéon-Sorbonne, where he co-directs its dynamic Centre d'histoire du 19^e Siècle [Center for the History of the 19th Century]. A specialist of cultural history, Kalifa has published *La Culture de masse en France, 1860–1930*, but his archival research into the history and representation

of crime and of private detectives has led to an array of publications including *Crime et culture au 19^e siècle* and *Naissance de la police privée en France, 1832–1942*. He is a regular contributor to the literary supplement of the French daily *Libération* and holds a joint appointment at the Institut d'Études Politiques in Paris, affectionately known as “Sciences Po.”
