Farooq Hassan is educated in law (Oxford, Cambridge, Lincoln's Inn London, Columbia, Harvard), in comparative systems and conflicts of laws (Columbia, Hague Academy), international and strategic affairs (Harvard), human rights (Harvard, International Institute of Human Rights: France), and humanitarian law and laws of war (Henry Dunant Institut: Geneva, Humanitarian Law Institute: San Remo, Italy). Hassan has been a tenured professor of law and has

taught at different leading universities and centers such as Oxford, London, Columbia, Tufts, and Fletcher. He has been an advisor to four prime ministers and the government of Pakistan, including diplomatic assignments representing Pakistan at the UN. He has authored over twenty-five books and over one hundred articles primarily in professional journals. He is currently president of the Boston-based American Institute of Asian Strategic Studies.
