Peter Martland is a member of the history faculty at Cambridge University. Martland teaches and supervises undergraduate and graduate students and is a lecturer in history for Pembroke College International Programmes, a research associate at Corpus Christi College, and has held a number of academic appointments in the university and elsewhere. He

published *Lord Haw Haw: the English Voice of Nazi Germany*, a biography of the notorious American-born Nazi broadcaster and propagandist based on the files held by MI5, and he was editor of *The Future of the Past*, a series of essays by distinguished Cambridge historians. Martland received a PhD in history from the University of Cambridge.
