He was the Fulbright bicentennial chair at the University of Helsinki (2011–12) and former Fulbright professor at the Sorbonne in Paris and the University of Toronto. His most recent book is *Revitalizing Governance, Restoring Prosperity, and Restructuring Foreign Affairs: The Pathway to Renaissance America*. In addition, Fry annually publishes a map of the GDP of U.S. states compared with nation-states around the world.
