

# ART & DESIGN IN EUROPE & MOROCCO

STUDY ABROAD SPRING 2019



The Art & Design in Europe & Morocco study abroad program offers students an intensive, on-site, studio experience which considers the vast French, Spanish and Moroccan contributions to contemporary art and design. Students will actively participate in art making experiences while visiting world famous museums such as The Louvre, Musee d'Orsay, Prado and Getty. While traveling throughout the area students will explore the rich cultural history of the Iberian Peninsula and visit attractions such as the Sagrada Familia, Versailles, the Alhambra, and others. Students will paint, draw, and design during excursions to Paris, Dordogne, Bilbao, Granada, Madrid, Barcelona, Toledo, Marrakesh, Fez and other locations.

## **HOUSING**

Students will be housed in a combination of private apartments, hostels and hotels.

## **COST**

\$6,800–7,300

Includes LDS, undergraduate full tuition (increased cost for grads and non-LDS), housing, transportation within Europe, admissions, and international health insurance coverage.

Not included:

Airfare to and from program, most meals, and personal expenses.

### **PREPARATION**

Although an emphasis will be placed on studio art and design courses, the program is open to all majors with an interest in art and design. Accepted students are required to participate in an international, cross-cultural preparation course (IAS 201, 1 credit hour). This evening course will be held Wednesdays 5:00-7:00 pm during the second block of winter semester 2019. (Part-time and non-BYU students will need to pay an additional \$294 tuition fee for enrolling in the prep class.)

Accompanying spouses need to be credit-bearing participants on the program. Spouses will also need to apply online and take the preparation course.

### **FUNDING SOURCES**

Regular BYU tuition scholarships, Pell Grants, and Federal Insured Student Loans may be applied to Study Abroad programs. Students who submit the financial aid section of the ISP application, and who have a current FAFSA form on file at the Financial Aid Office (A-41 ASB), will be considered for a Study Abroad scholarship. Academic departments and colleges may assist with scholarships and grants. Private grants and scholarships outside of BYU may also assist (see [kennedy.byu.edu/ispscholarships/](http://kennedy.byu.edu/ispscholarships/)).
