- Perfect Grammar and Spelling
- Correct use of the English Language (Spanish for OAS)
- Use of the Template
- Well-Researched Content

### Questions to Consider:

- In which committees or organizations does your country participate?
- How does your country participate?
- What did your country do in the past?
- What is your country currently doing?
- What attitude does your country have towards the issue?
- What reason does your country give for its positions?
- If your country does not have an explicit policy or position, what can you infer from the policies or positions of sister countries in the same region?
