Making Foreign Policy Today – And Why Incoherence May Be Here to Stay



Dennis Jett is a professor of international affairs at Pennsylvania State University. A former career diplomat, he served 28 years in the State Department in a wide range of positions including as Ambassador to Peru and Mozambique, on the National Security Council, and in Argentina, Israel, Malawi and Liberia. From 2000 to 2008, he was Dean of the International Center at the University of Florida. He has a Ph.D. in international relations from the University of Witwatersrand in South Africa. He has written four books -- “Why Peacekeeping Fails”, “American Ambassadors-The Past, Present and Future of America’s Diplomats”, “The Iran Nuclear Deal-Bombs, Billionaires and Bureaucrats”, and “Why American Foreign Policy Fails”, all published by Palgrave Macmillan. He has been interviewed on PBS, CNN, NPR, BBC, CBC and other national and international news programs and has written over 170 opinion pieces for major newspapers. He is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations in New York and the American Academy of Diplomacy.
